KAPAMBA BUSHCAMP

S 13°22.964' – E031°31.564'

Open: April to January

Kapamba Bushcamp is a quiet sanctuary set in a pristine game-rich area in the remote, southern section of the South Luangwa National Park. With four stone-and-thatch chalets, a main area and deck with 180-degree views of the Kapamba River and the option to sleep out under the stars in a raised sala, Kapamba allows you to see, hear and feel Africa.

ACCOMMODATION

- 4 x open-fronted chalets, all with twin beds that can be combined to form an imperial King-size bed.
- Wrought-iron gates are drawn over for safety in the evenings.
- All rooms have a twin showers (with views of the river), wash-basin and toilet.
- 2 x rooms have raised salas with mosquito net, toilet & sink underneath, perfect for sleeping under the stars!
- Solar-powered hot & cold running water.
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, conditioner, skin moisturizer) are provided.
- Standing floor fans & mosquito nets.



FACILITIES

- The large main lounge and dining area extends to a tiered deck; all have beautiful views of the the Kapamba River.
- Swimming pool overlooking the river.
- There is a fully stocked bar in camp.
- The camp is powered by solar; limited charging facilities are available.
- Lighting is by solar light and paraffin lamps.
- There is a limited laundry service free of charge.



ACTIVITIES

- Day and night game drives.
- Walking safaris.
- Private guide and vehicle are available at an additional cost. Please enquire for details.
- Specially-adapted photographic vehicle also available.
- Sundowners in the river.

CHILD POLICY

Children aged 12 years and older are welcome at Kapamba. As children under 12 years are not allowed to participate in walking safaris in the Park, families travelling with children aged 11 years and younger will need to reserve a private camp or hire a Private Guide & Vehicle for the duration of their stay at any of our Bushcamps.



DRIVING TIMES

- All guests will be met at Mfuwe International Airport and taken by vehicle to Mfuwe Lodge (45 mins) for refreshments before travelling on to Kapamba Bushcamp.
- Mfuwe Lodge to Kapamba Bushcamp – approximately 2 – 3 hrs game-viewing speed; driving through the South Luangwa National Park.

AIRPORT DETAILS

- The closest airport is Mfuwe International Airport.
- For scheduled flights into Mfuwe International Airport there is normally a 23kg per person maximum luggage allowance (packed in soft bags).
- The flight time from Lusaka 1hr 10mins.
- Kapamba Airstrip is also available for charter flights and is located only 30-minutes drive from Kapamba.

GRATUITIES

Gratuities are dependent on the guests' satisfaction with the level of service provided; there is no obligation to tip. Below is a guideline should you find the service exceptional:

- In the region of US\$5.00 to US\$20.00 per guest per day for guides
- In the region of US\$5.00 to US\$20.00 per guest per day for general staff

TEMPERATURE & CLIMATE

The South Luangwa has mild winter days from May to mid-August, with chilly evenings. From September through April it is generally quite warm.

- Dry season – May through October
- Rainy season – November through April
- Hottest months – October & November (before the rains start around mid-November)

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
